

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Reporting Requirement Not Met for PWSD No. 8 Clay County, Missouri

We were required to report a copy of the notice and materials sent to persons served by known or potential service lines containing lead to the State.

Our system failed to submit certification to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources confirming that required notifications were delivered to affected consumers with lead, galvanized requiring replacement (GRR), or lead status unknown service lines by the July 1, 2025 deadline.

Although failure to comply with this reporting requirement does not create a risk to public health, we are required to inform you of this violation and provide additional information about what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

Customers have already been notified if their service line is known or suspected to contain lead, galvanized requiring replacement (GRR), or is of unknown material, so they can make informed decisions about reducing potential exposure to lead in drinking water.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions. Remember, boiling water does not remove lead from water.

What is being done?

While we did not submit the certification to the State by the required deadline, all required notifications to affected customers were completed. The required certification and information were submitted to the State on April 9, 2026. We are reviewing our internal procedures to ensure all future reporting requirements are completed on time.
